



Introduction to Peer Support

Introduction to Peer Support is a comprehensive course designed for responders, veteran responders, and the family members who support them. The course blends classroom instruction with hands-on practice and explores the purpose and boundaries of peer support; the impacts of acute, cumulative, and traumatic stress; and the neurobiology that shapes human responses under pressure, including moral injury.

Participants build core competencies in presence-based support, emotional regulation, active listening, and asking effective questions, while learning how to navigate difficult conversations, maintain healthy boundaries, recognize burnout, and make appropriate referrals.

The course concludes with a required 4-hour in-person skills lab featuring realistic role-plays, grounding techniques, and applied use of the Peer Support Compass.
